


Project Scope

- Construction of a new 9-12th Grade high school located on the former Cherokee Lane Elementary School Site
 - 2,000 Comprehensive students
 - 600 Career & Technology Education (CTE) students
- The high school has 22 CTE programs integrated throughout including Automotive, Construction, Cosmetology, Culinary, Technology, and Healthcare trades.
- A new access drive will provide access to the school and ultimately connect to the new Cherokee Lane Elementary School and Buck Lodge Middle School.

Anticipated Project Timeline

October 2021	Schematic Submission - Completed
August 2021 - Present	Coordination with University of Maryland Shared Sports Facility
Summer 2024	Completion of Design Development
Spring 2025	Construction Documents - Ongoing
Fall 2025 - Spring 2028	Construction Phase 1 - Five-Story Classroom Wing
Summer 2026 - Fall 2026	Demolition of Old Cherokee Lane Elementary School Building
Fall 2026 - Summer 2028	Construction Phase 2 - Public Spaces Wing
Fall 2028	Occupancy for High Point High School students
Fall 2031	Occupancy for New Northern Adelphi Area High School students



Current Status

- The educational specifications were approved by Board of Education on September 23, 2021; there were some minor revisions to reflect swing space.
- Discussions are underway with University of Maryland in regards to an access road and joint-use of its stadium.
- The project will house High Point High School students during the replacement of the current High Point High School.
 - The CTE classrooms will supplement regular classrooms.
 - The CTE classrooms will revert back to CTE spaces the summer before permanent occupancy.

- Meetings with PGCPS and school leadership.
- Meetings with University of Maryland.
- Safety concerns and protocols under consideration by project and school leadership.


