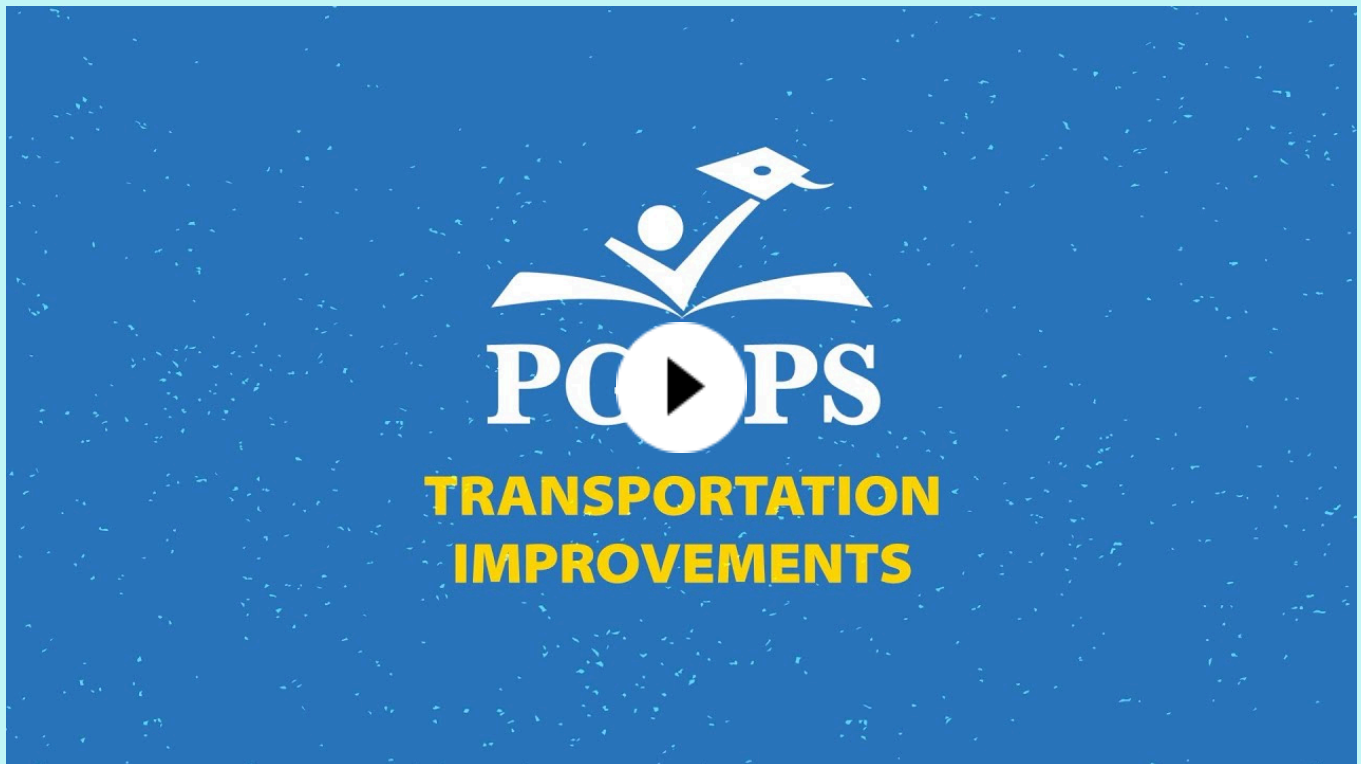

Largo Boys Basketball Wins State Finals

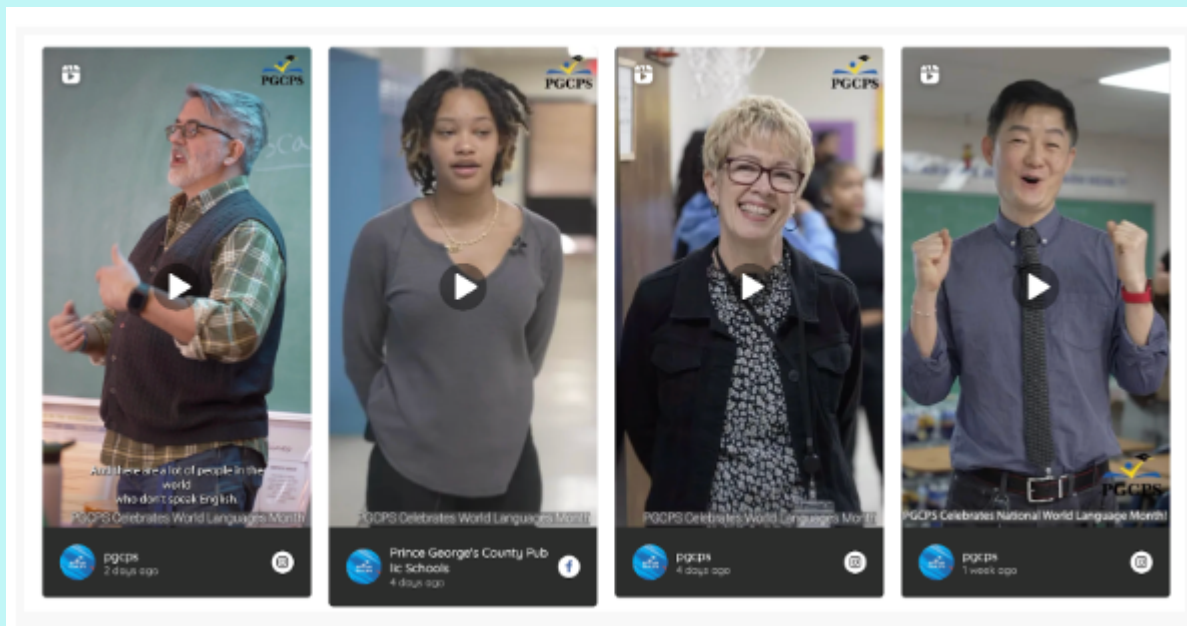

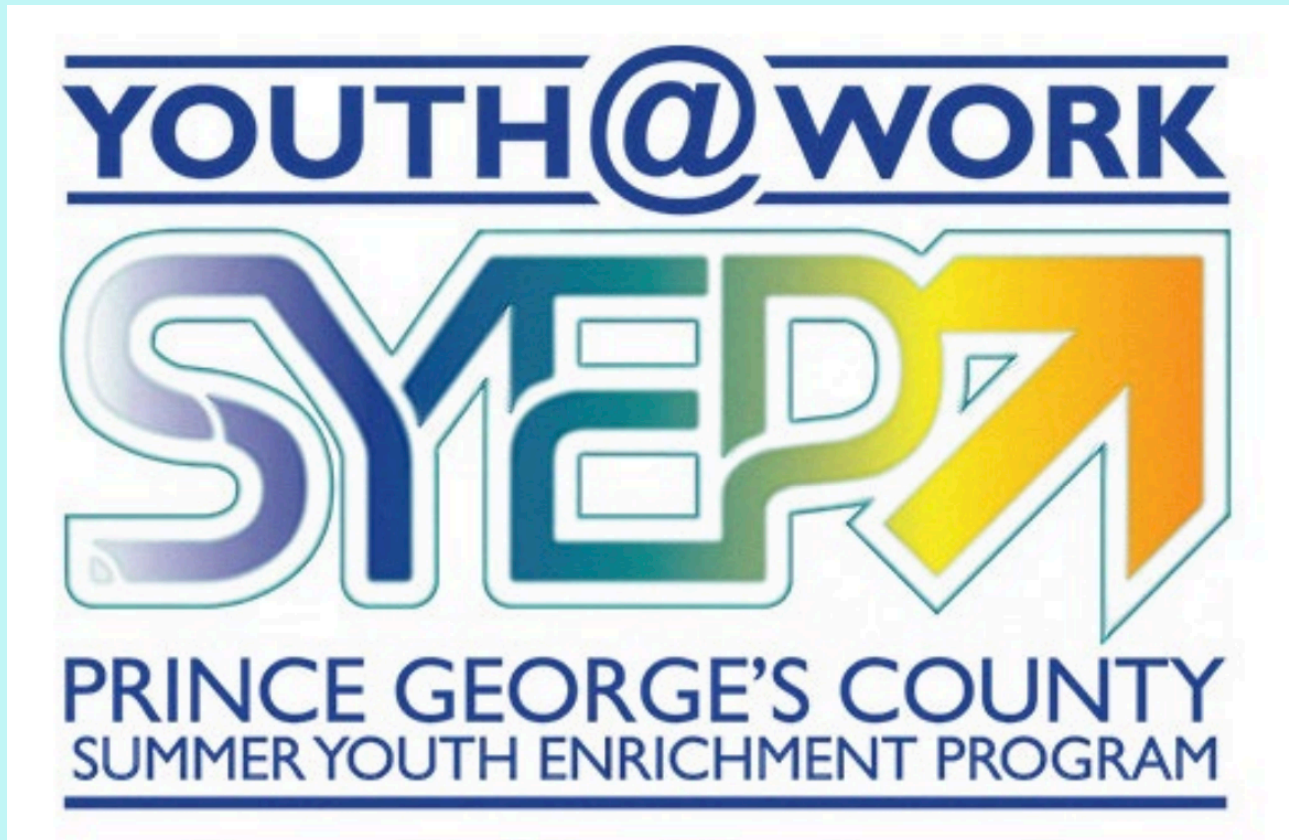
