What we are learning this Month:

For Hispanic Heritage Month, students in grades 4th and 5th will be drawing either the national bird, national flower, or national fruit from a Spanish speaking country of their choice. 3rd grade will be using rulers, scissors, and glue to create paper flags. 1st and 2nd grade are currently making paper pinatas, and they will continue to work on types of lines, shapes and patterns throughout their next art projects.
