Reading/ELA (Ms. Ndiaye)

This month, 4th graders will be learning how to identify literacy skills within a text (Point of View, Figurative Language, etc.). Students will also begin their vocabulary study and analytic writing.

S.S./Science (Ms. Totten)

Science: In this unit, students learn about forces, energy, and collisions by studying the physics of car crashes.

Social Studies: Students will investigate what it means to think like a historian and how where one lives influences how we view the world.

Math (Mrs. Lyons)

This month, 4th graders will use expanded form to show their place value understanding. We will also add and subtract large numbers using estimation, pictures, numbers, and words as well as open number lines to support our calculations.
